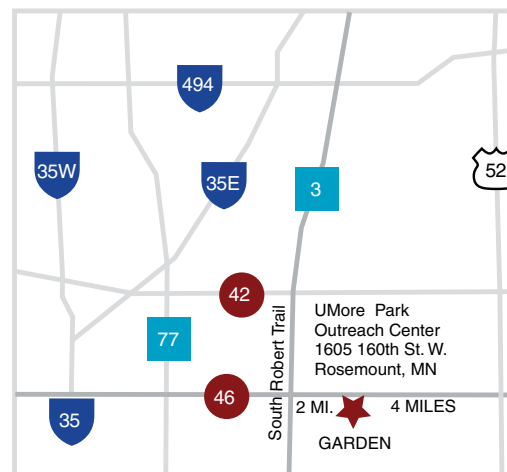
The Garden is free to the public and open daily. Plenty of free parking is available. Visit our web site, www.mggarden.umn.edu for more info.

Directions from the St. Paul Area:

- From the downtown St. Paul area, take Highway 52 south to County Road 46 (160th St)
- Take County Road 46 west about 3 miles
- Look for a gazebo and a large maroon and gold floral "M" on your left

Directions from the Rosemount Area:

- Go east on County Road 42 to Highway 3 (Robert Trail South)
- Take Highway 3 south to Country Road 46 (160th Street) and turn left
- Travel two miles and look for a gazebo and a large maroon and gold floral "M" on your right
